# SCRAP OF THE HISTORY

OF

Frank P. Blair Post No. 1, Department of Missouri,

G. A. R.

On the first of December, 1879, an application was made and a charter was granted by Department Commander J. C. Walkinshaw, of Kansas, authorizing the muster of a Post in the City of St. Louis.

A preliminary meeting for the muster of Union veterans was held December 8, 1879, in the law office of ex-Governor Fletcher, corner Fifth and Pine Streets, at which time Department Commander J. C. Walkinshaw of Kansas, with the assistance of Comrades F. R. Fotter and J. B. Pachall, who were members of Posts in other states, proceeded to muster John Reed, Thos. B. Rodgers and Stillman O. Fish; and at a second meeting at the same place, held December 16, 1879, J. W. Francis, Robert B. Beck, G. Harry Stone and John O'Connell were mustered. The Post was duly mustered January 8, 1880, by Department Commander Walkinshaw, at Phil. A. Bamberger's parlors on Fifth Street, opposite the Court House.

The charter of the Post bears date December 1, 1879, and includes the names of the following comrades, who had been mustered up to January 6, 1880: John Reed, Thomas B. Rodgers, Stillman O. Fish, John W. Francis, Robert B. Beck, G. Harry Stone, John O'Connell, George G. Chase, Richard Mollencott, F. R. Potter, J. B. Pachall, Lewis Moore, E. M. Joel, Barney Seaman and Arthur Dreifus. The Post was named Frank P. Blair Post No. 1, of Missouri, but for the time being was within the jurisdiction of the Department of Kansas. The election of officers was held February 14, 1880, and officers were installed by J. C. Walkinshaw, Department Commander of Kansas, at a special meeting held February 19, 1880.

The first regular place of meeting was Wenzel's Hall, at Eighth Street and Franklin Avenue; second place was in Justice Monahan's office, at Seventh and Olive Streets; third place was Masonic Hall, Seventh and

Market Streets; fourth place was the Druid's Hall, Ninth and Market Streets; fifth place was on Sixth Street, between Chestnut and Pine Streets; sixth place was Seventeenth and Olive streets; seventh place, "Frank P. Blair Hall," corner of Seventeenth and Market Streets.

The Provisional Department of Missouri was organized by request of Frank P. Blair Post. General Order No. 10, National Headquarters, dated Dayton, Ohio, April 23, 1880, and signed by Commander-in-Chief Wm. Earnshaw, contains the following paragraph: "III. Comrade John S. Cavender is announced as Commander of the Provisional Department of Missouri." General Order No. 11, National Headquarters, dated May 18, 1882, contains: "IV. The appointment of Comrade David Murphy, Ass't Adj't General of the Department of Missouri, is hereby confirmed."

From the date of muster Frank P. Blair Post has been fairly successful; we may say, wonderfully so in numerical progress, in financial ability, and the character of membership. It was the pioneer Post, and had to take the lead and assume the responsibility of doing things first, with the chances of failure. It was the first to adopt a uniform; the first to hold camp-fires; the first to make street parades; and the first to perform service-book ceremonies on Memorial Day at Jefferson Barracks, and the first to dedicate a hall for its own use.

Frank P. Blair Post was the first organization in St. Louis, to observe Lincoln's birthday (February 12) in some form, and continues to do so every year.

The Post has since its organization mustered 1,410 members, and from its membership several of the best Posts of the City of St. Louis were organized.

It has the largest Relief Fund of any Post in the Department of Missouri, and has since 1882 expended \$13,271.48 for the assistance of needy comrades.

Nearly all the States are represented on its roster.

It is the largest Post in Missouri.

 age; discharged June, 1865.

The Seventeenth Army Corps Headquarter Flag was  
 presented to the Post by the Widow of Gen. Frank P.  
 Blair. The great battles and marches in which it was  
 carried are engraved on the flag-staff.

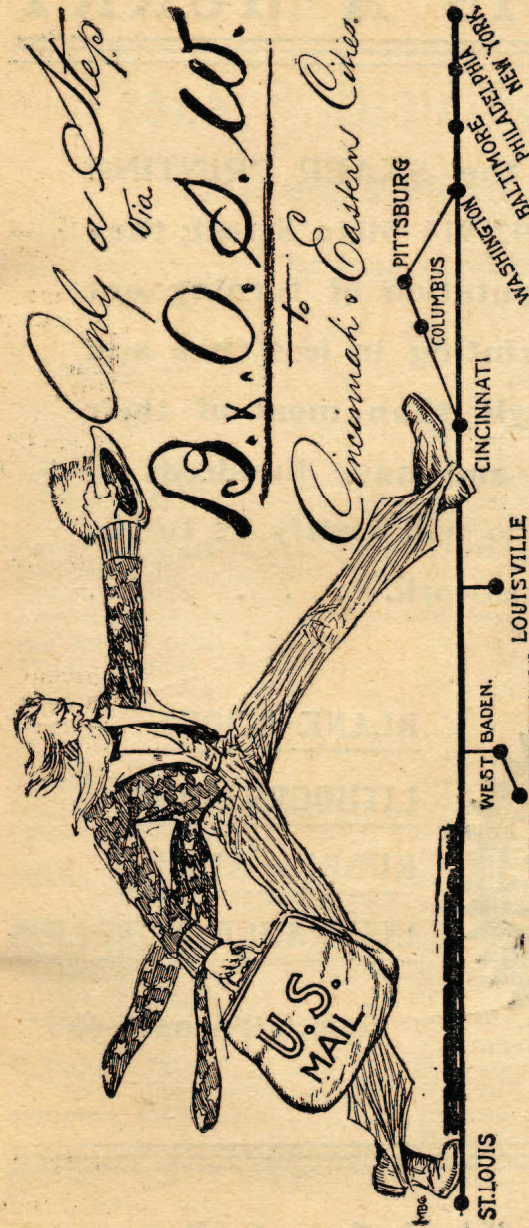

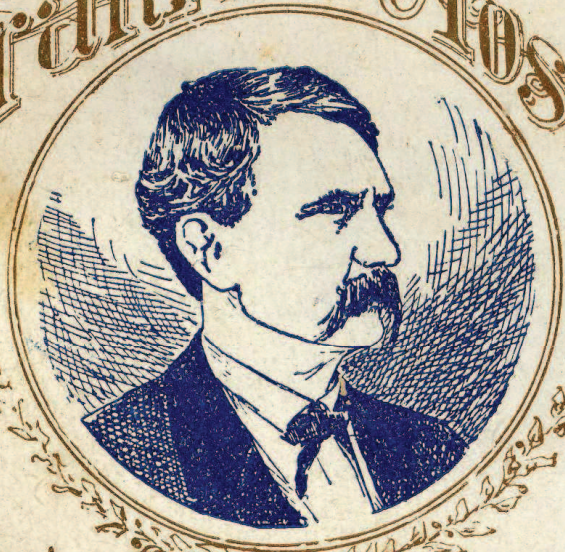

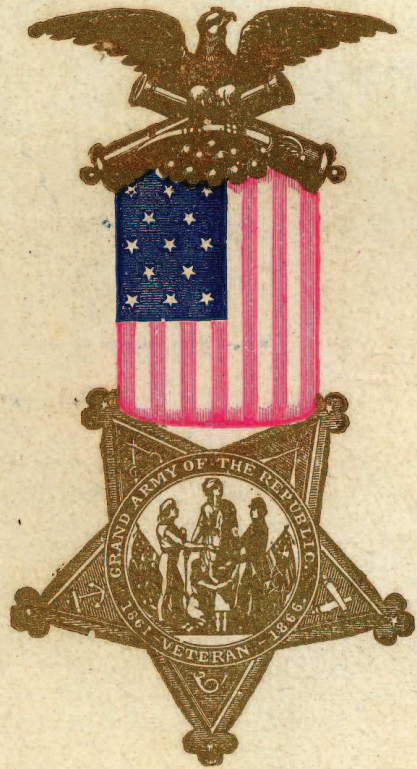

# ST. LOUIS POST-DISI ONLY 69 CIVIL WAR VETERANS IN ST. LOUIS

Youngest is P. H. Callahan,  
81, Who Served in  
Union Army.

Sixty-five years since Lee's surrender finds only 11 of his former followers surviving in St. Louis and 58 Union veterans still living. Many were too feeble to take part in Memorial Day services today; the youngest in the city, P. H. Callahan, a Union veteran, being 81 years old.

At one time flourishing organizations, the Grand Army of the Republic and United Confederate Veterans today are represented by a few white-haired men and gradually diminishing membership lists. It is estimated that there were once 3000 Confederate veterans in the city and from 8000 to 9000 Union men.

In its peak year the Confederate group numbered from 20,000 to 25,000 in Missouri. This has now tumbled down to less than 2000. The Union veterans have shrunk likewise from 25,000 to 500.

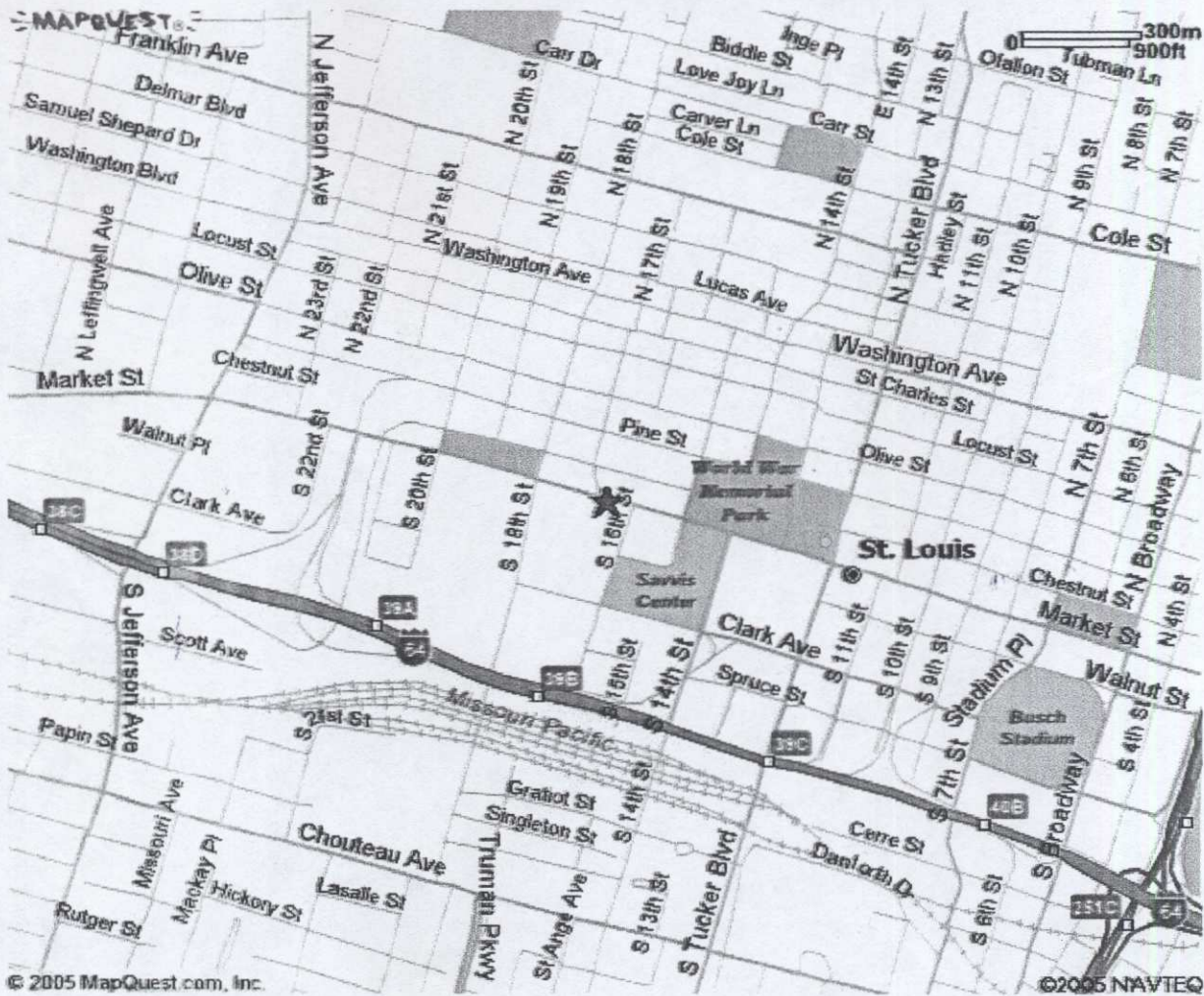
