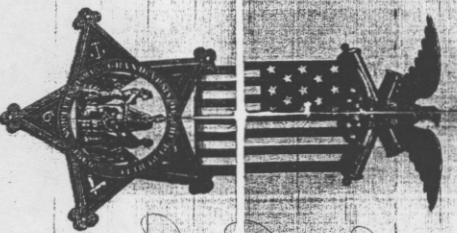

Dated at the Head Quarters of the Department of the Missouri on the 11th day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Sixty five and of our Independence the One hundred and Ninety
