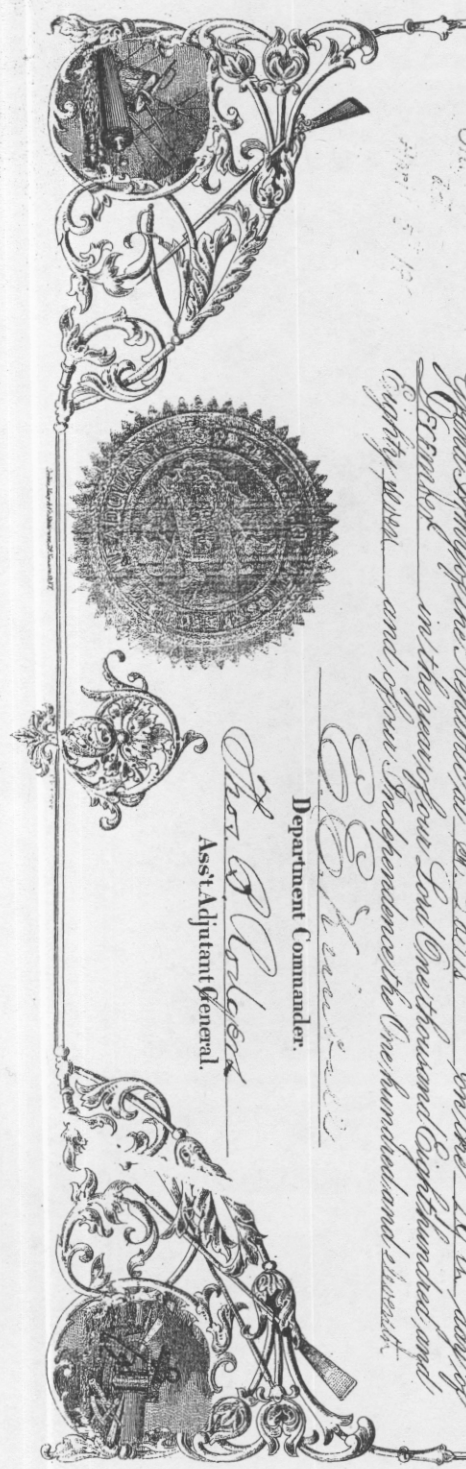

December, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and  
Eighty seven, and of our Independence the One hundred and twenty  
Eighth.
