

The Steins Broadway Condominium Showroom at 7529 South Broadway was Katz Dry Goods and before that the Old Town Saloon, dating back prior to 1881 according to their website <http://www.steinsbroadwaycondos.com/neighborhood.php>. As the information about the Garesche Post was from the 1887 Encampment Book, it confirms this as the building..





