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Post Information

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Brief History of the G.A.R. Post (use separate document if necessary):

A Grand Army of the Republic Post was organized in Jackson, Missouri, the 19 February 1887. They adopted the name of Hazen No. 310 of the Missouri Department of G.A.R. They elected Jacob H. Schaefer as their leader. The Hazen No. 310 post of the G.A.R. met the first and second Saturdays of each month.
In March of 1887 they changed their name to A.B. Carrol G.A.R. Post 310 in honor of the late Major Alonzo Barney Carroll. Major Carroll died 13 January 1887 and is buried in Old Lorimier Cemetery in Cape Girardeau, Missouri.
The A.B. Carroll Post and the Odd Fellows built a hall in Jackson in 1888, The hall was dedicated 9 September 1888 after which a picnic was held on the old Jackson Fair Ground. The event closed that night with a grand ball at Turner Hall in Jackson, Missouri. The G.A.R.-O.F. Hall was later turned into living areas moved and later destroyed. (Taken from newspapers found on microfilm)

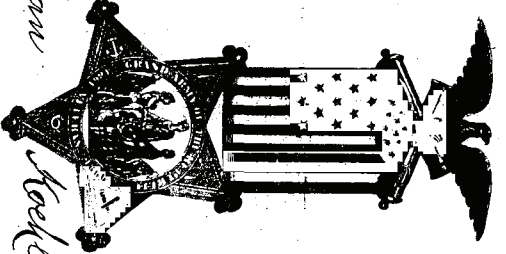

And I authorize and empower them to perform all acts necessary to conduct said organization in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Grand Army of the Republic.

Dated at the Head Quarters of the Department of Missouri of the Grand Army of the Republic at St. Louis on the 22nd day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and eighty four and of our Independence the one hundred and sixth.
