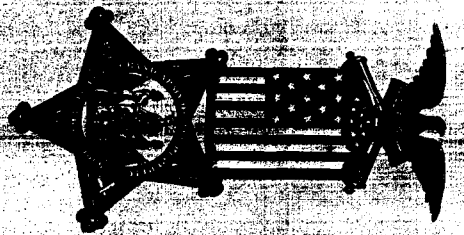

Pennington Department of Missouri No. 34 & Trickton, Lincoln Co.

Said I authorize and empower them to perform all acts necessary to conduct said organization in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Grand Army of the Republic.

Given at the State Quarter of the Department of Missouri of the Grand Army of the Republic at St. Louis on the first day of July 1862 in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty given under and upon the hand and seal of the said Levi F. Pennington
