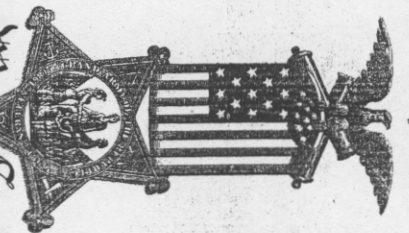

Dated at the Head Quarters of the Department of Missouri of the Grand Army of the Republic, at St. Louis on the 22nd day of Jan in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Eighty eight and of our Independence the One hundred and twelfth.
