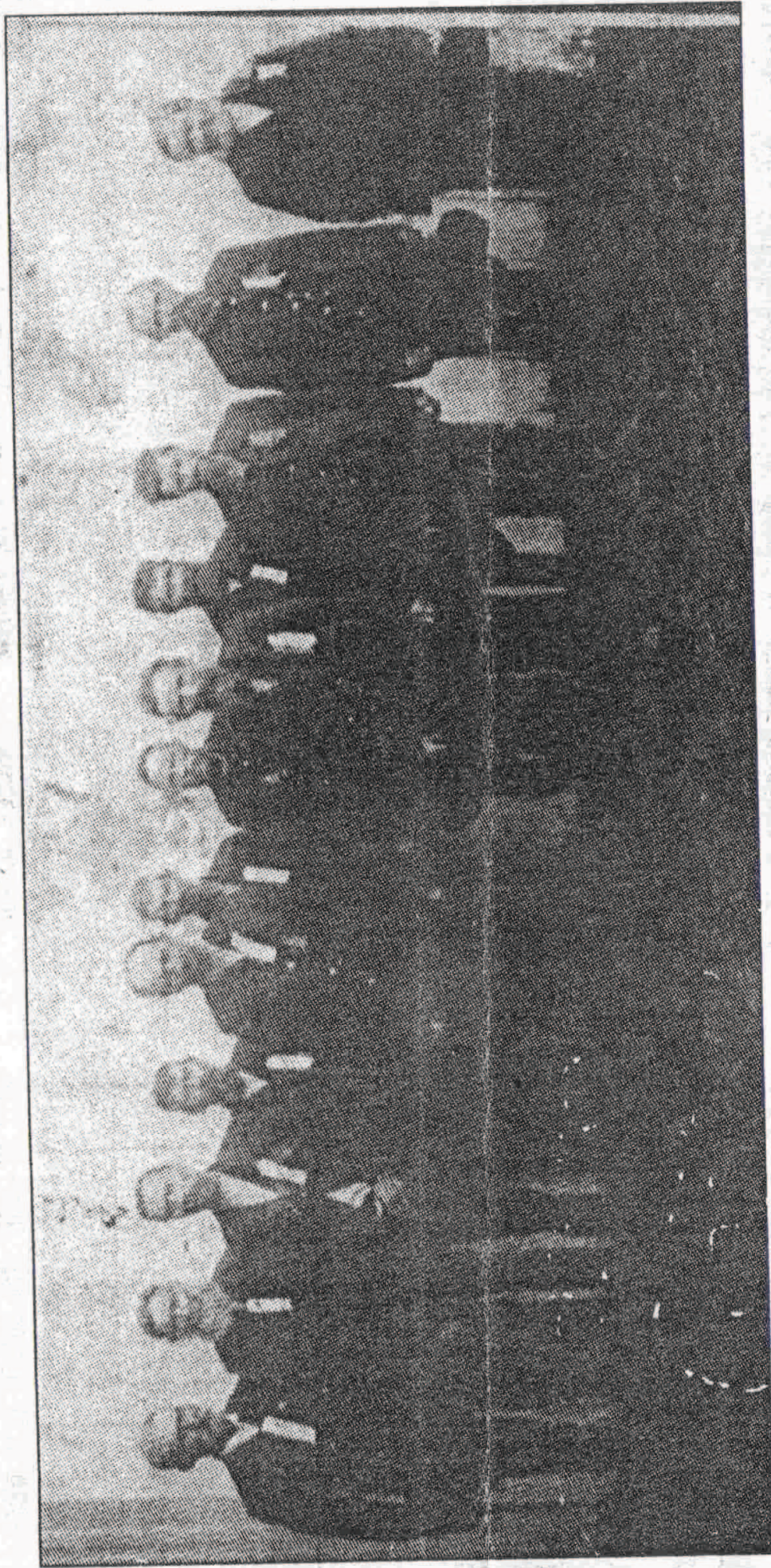

Gen. George G. Meade Post No. 48, G. A. R., was organized December 21, 1882. First officers: R. C. Barrows, Past C.; John B. Hickman, Sen. Vice; J. V. Fleck, J. V.; Luke Joslin, Chap.; F. E. Lambar, O. D.; John Krudwig, O. G.; E. M. Harrison, Surg.; John G. Lingsweiler, Q. M.; S. R. Apperson, Adjt.; A. Fayant, Sergt. Maj.; A. A. West, Q. M. Sergt. Present officers: A. C. Gavan, P. C.; J. W. Appling, S. V.; C. G. Manchester, J. V.; John O. Estes, Chap.; A. A. Tayman, Surg.; R. C. Barrows, O. D.; J. B. Hickman, O. G.; J. C. Wallace, Q. M.; W. V. Farris, Q. M. Sergt.; A. Fayant, Sergt. Maj.; W. H. Turner, Adjt. This post was organized with thirty members; has had five deaths

and now has 147 members. Capt. C. W. Rubey is Aid-de-Camp on the staff of the National Commander, and also District Inspector. S. R. Apperson is Aid-de-Camp on the staff of the Department Commander.

Sons of Veterans, Col. J. W. McClurg Camp No. 72, was organized in January, 1888, with twenty-six charter members. It now has a membership of thirty-five. The camp purchased uniforms, and they make a fine appearance. It is hoped that they may perpetuate in memory the deeds of their fathers.
