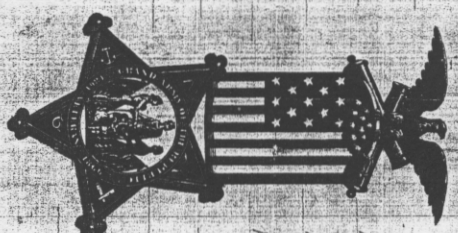

Department of Missouri

and I authorize and empower them to perform all acts necessary to conduct said organization in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Grand Army of the Republic.

Dated at the Head Quarters of the Department of Missouri of the Grand Army of the Republic at St. Louis, Mo. this 24th day of January 1892 in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and Ninety Two and of our Independence the One hundred and Sixty fifth.
