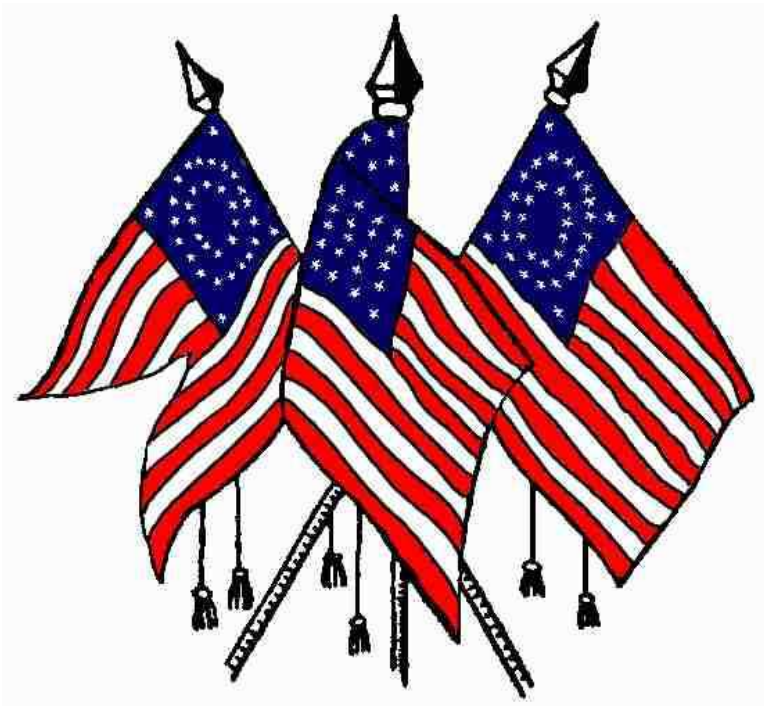

**Graves Registration Officer Report  
Department of Missouri, SUVCW  
16 October 2010**

**TO: Chief of Staff, Department of Missouri, SUVCW**

Our current listings from Missouri and Arkansas on the National Graves Registration Database number 16,181 and 6,472 respectively for a total of 22,653. Phelps Camp (thru Jeff Patrick) has submitted an additional 37, Westport Camp (Dale Crandell) reported 10 more and St James Camp (Gary Scheel) is working on a stack of more than 400 from Bob Schmidt.

Two citations were issued to Ruth Kasten and Jerry Kasten by the National GRO Bruce Frail and the presentation was made to them at the September meeting of the St. James Camp in Ste. Genevieve, MO. The two had logged 1185 graves last year.

In late September, four SUVCW members including brothers Gary Scheel, Department Commander Rod Price, Charlie ~~Price~~ <sup>Price</sup>, and I traveled to Jacksonville, MO for the interment of the remains of Pvt John Kling and his wife, Elizabeth. Reportedly, the Klings' remains had gone unclaimed since his demise in 1918 and hers in 1923. They were laid to rest in a separate portion of the Missouri Veterans Cemetery after an impressive ceremony well-attended by veterans, school children and members of the Missing in America Project instrumental in locating their remains. It is also considered to have been the first Civil War soldier to have been buried in a Missouri Veterans Cemetery. The *Moberly Mirror & County Observer* publisher, Janet Morales, reported the 17 SEP 2010 event.

If one has not investigated the National database, it might come as a surprise that it has grown to approximately 536,524 names. It might further surprise that there are graves registered from neighboring Canada (263) and Mexico (34) as well as Australia (93), China, India, South Africa, New Zealand and Turkey. Eight are listed as MIA while 40 others are registered as burials "AT SEA".

In years gone by, it was a practice that past GAR members had coffin attachments placed on their coffins identifying them as GAR members.

Past DC Brian Smarker raised the issue that we have them made for our Department as Tombstone attachments. At several past business meetings, we talked about having gravestone attachments for SUVCW Past Department Commanders and later discussed that Life members be included. Several other members added their ideas and the idea struck me that these (GSA) could also be offered to the general membership.

I began gathering information on the manufacturing these (GSA's). I found that they can be made at a reasonable cost (at this time approx. \$4.00 to \$8.50 each depending on which company and type attachment) and offered to members of the Department of Missouri probable in the neighborhood of between \$20.00 and \$30.00. They would be numbered sequentially for record keeping and data retrieval. Attached by GS epoxy.

During our National Encampment, I contacted National Quartermaster, Dan Wheeler, and explained to him our concept, where he was surprisingly excited about the idea and suggested we show the idea to National Committee and to sell nationally. I was invited by him to go to National Committee and present the idea to them for permission to use copyrighted material.

A copyrighted image can be used as in a proof and not be sold or any monetary gain but used solely as intended, as a sample so as to be judged for further development. During this time a request to manufacture and sell the GSA, would be done. No one wishes to infringe on copyrights!


I'm requesting that, after further discussion at our this meeting, money be set-aside in the budget, for the eventual purchase of the GSA and that I only use my money, if necessary, for purchase of the proof. I think this is such a good and profitable way to help alleviate some of our monetary worries.

A very important matter comes up on an idea that several of us had. Walt Busch, Dan Wheeler and myself thought that we could share cost and profit with camps within our Department. I proceeded to advance that idea not as a vote toward startup but to give all camps information of the opportunity that they could share with the Department and to be voted on at a later date.

However, PDC Smarker advised against it, sighting an unfair advantage against the smaller Camps. I began to see that a money paper trail would become a possibly daunting task and open doors to a difficult bookkeeping procedures. So the idea of offering a partnership with our individual camps should be scrapped!

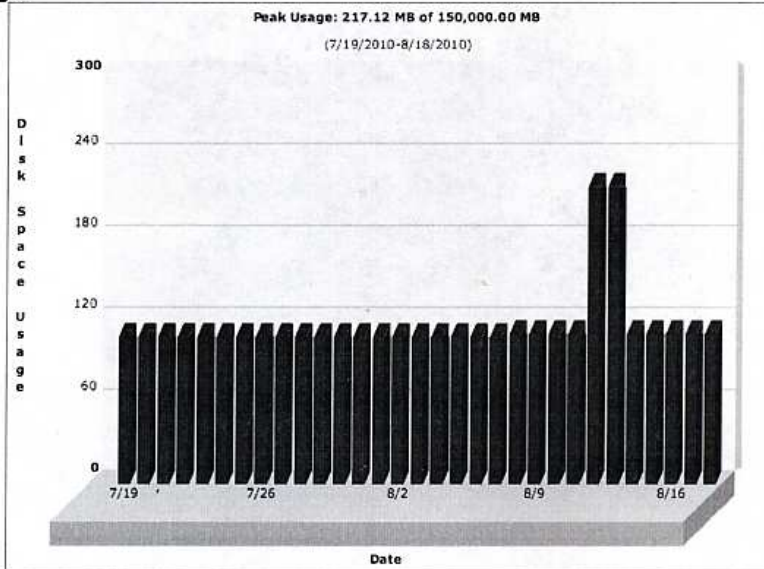

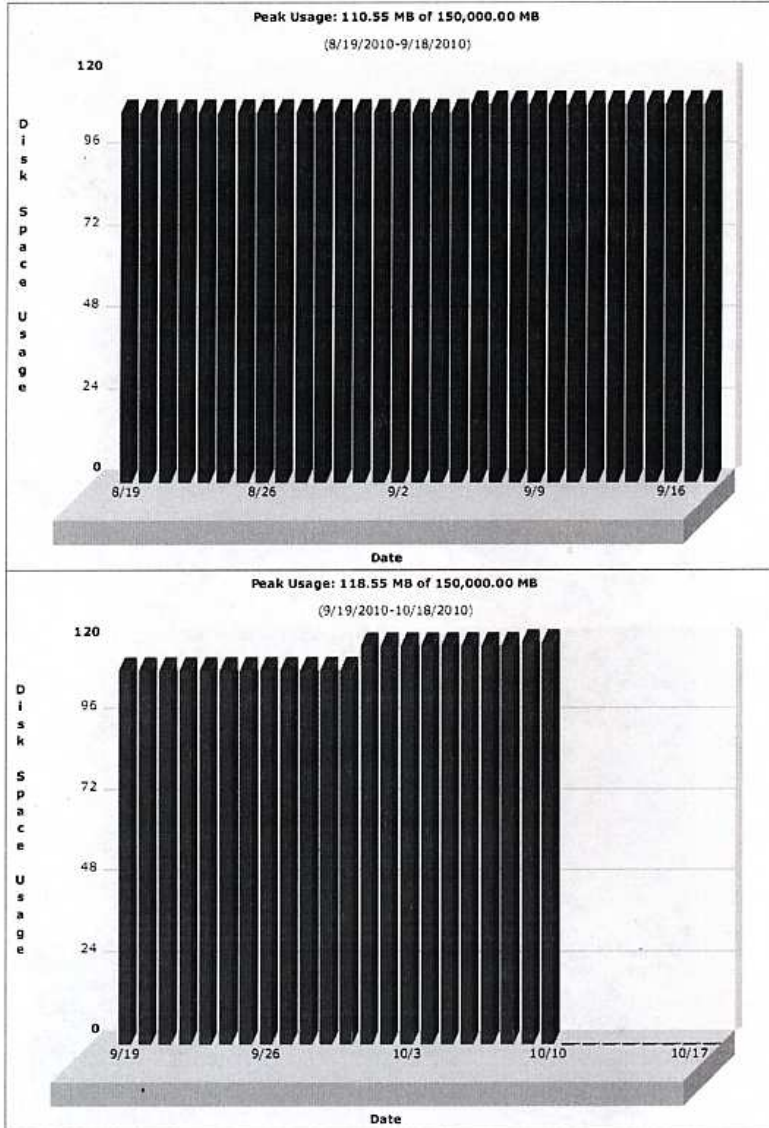
