Billings, William W. (25 Dec 1840 or 1842 - 19

Mar 1934) Private, Company B, 29th MO Infantry is buried in the Old Slaybaugh Cemetery in the Old Lutesville area of eastern Marble Hill in Bollinger County. He was born in Chestnut Ridge, TN and died in Crystal City, MO. After the war, he married Julia Ann Boan and settled in



Bollinger Co. He was wounded in action outside Atlanta in late July, 1864 fighting under Sherman. He named a son, William Sherman. He was a Charter Member of GAR Post #100 in Marble Hill Per MO Death certificate #9425; burial 21/Mar/1934. Death certificate has birth as Jan. 24, 1840; but age calculates to Dec. 1900 census has birth as Jan/1842.
