

Henry Fairback 1905

Henry was born to Anselm and Machdelane (Hesse) Fairack in Germany on Nov 25, 1839. He worked as a contractor and builder in the St. Louis area. He was a member of Post 131 in St. Louis. He wrote autobiography: *A Wanderer: Being a Brief Sketch of the Civil and Military Experiences of Henry Fairback*. Published 1912. He died on December 4, 1913 and is buried in Bellefontaine Cemetery, St. Louis.
