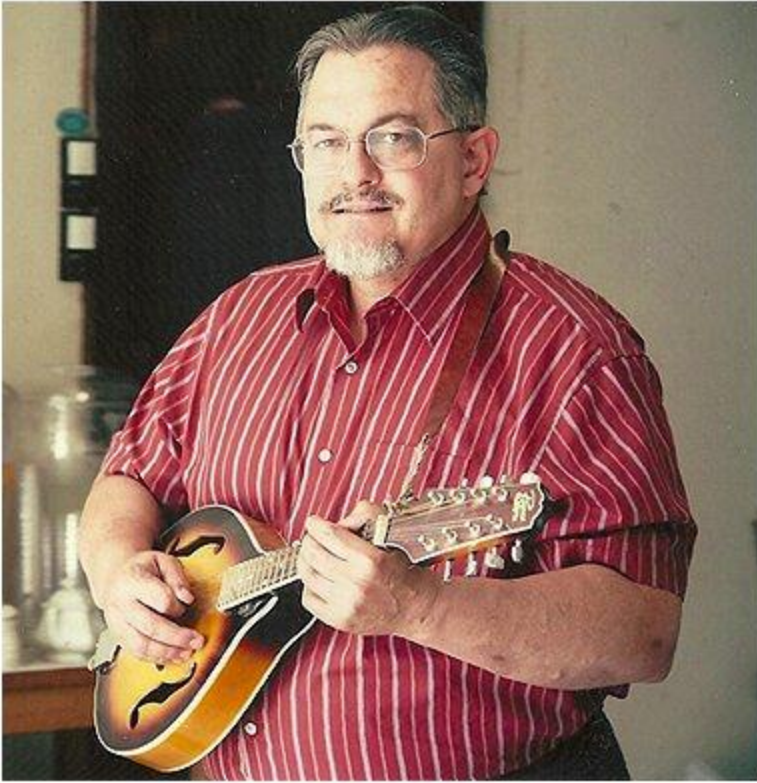


IN MEMORY OF PERRY “BUD” MARKS, JR.
