Lived in Versailles for last 30 years of life. Son of Richard R Boyce and Mary Ellen Griffin. Husband of Elizabeth Russell. Buried at Dooley Cemetery, Franklin Township - Section 12 -Township 41 - Range 16 West - Miller County, MO..

John Frederick Schluesing (1843 – 1930) Served Co F, Benton Co Home Guards 13 June -13 Sept 1861, Battle of Cole Camp June 19th. Reenlisted in Co K, 25th Illinois Inf on 30 Sept 1861 "was in Battles of Pea Ridge, Stones River, Chickamauga, Missionary Ridge, and Kennesaw Mountain. Discharged 30 Sept 1864 at Alatoona, Georgia and returned to Morgan Co. Died in Knobnoster, Mo.
