Speaking of activities, our newest camp member, John Petersen, gave a presentation at the Rolla Public Relations Club luncheon on 26 March 2014 on the important role played by Rolla during the Civil War. Rolla was the end of the rail line at the time and was captured by Union forces led by General Franz Sigel on June 14, 1861 and held until the end of the war. Rolla was a staging point for Union forces and a processing point for Confederate soldiers and sympathizers who were arrested or captured and taken to prisons in St. Louis and Illinois.

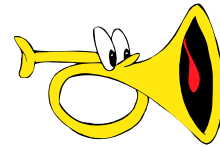

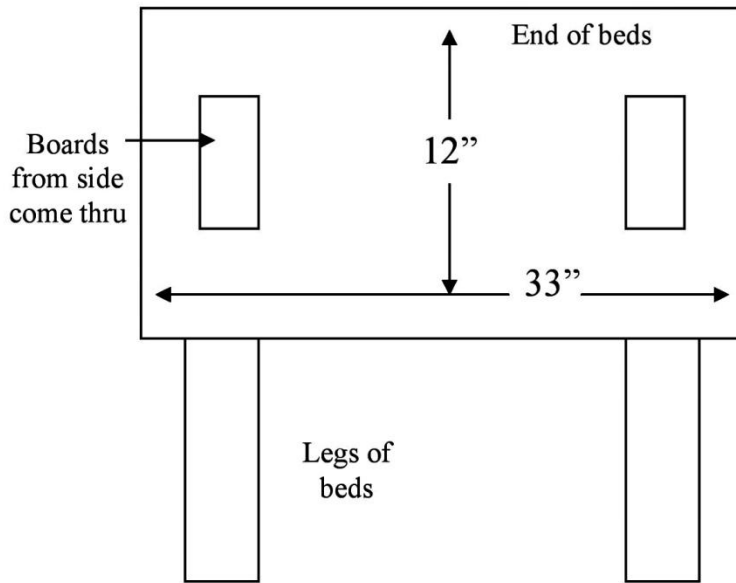
## CINC’S RESPONSE TO LETTER REGARDING GENERAL ORDER #3

“When we decided to take action on this situation that was long overdue for action, The Council of Administration and myself, weighed all the options and it was unanimously decided on this course of action.

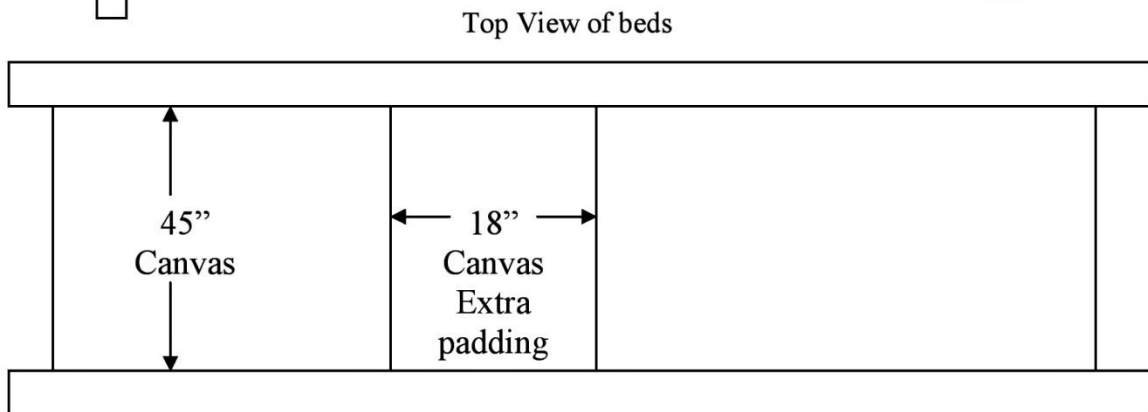
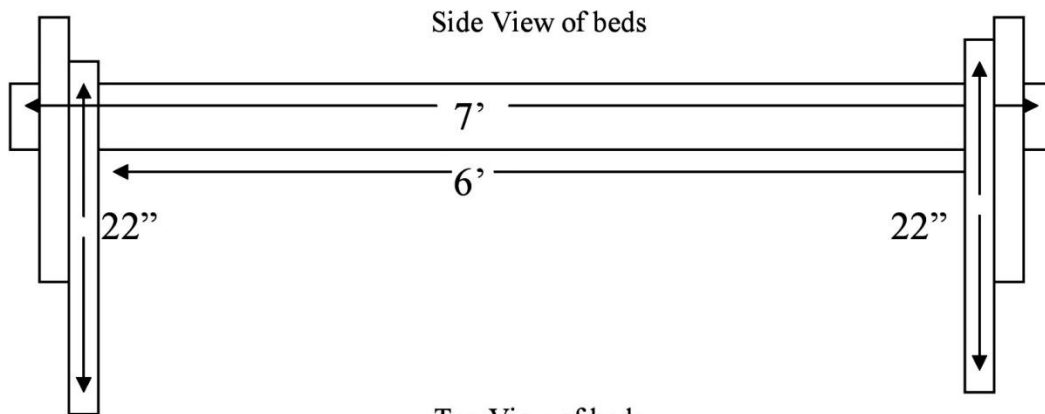
We knew that this General Order #3 would not be agreeable to everyone, but the ultimate outcome of this will far out way the temporary inconvenience that we experiencing now.

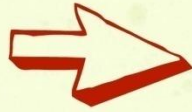
