Company K, 4th Infantry, 3rd Division, U.S. Army
Medal of Honor Recipient**

National Medal of Honor Day honors the 3,496 men and women whose service and sacrifices were recognized with the nation's highest medal, the Medal of Honor. Awarded since the Civil War and often called the Congressional Medal of Honor, there are 34 deceased recipients buried in the greater Kansas City area.

SUVCW Westport Camp along with other local lineage and veteran groups is conducting a commemoration for this World War I medal recipient buried at Forest Hills Cemetery. Private Barkley was one of two from the 4th Infantry to be awarded the Medal for service during the Meuse-Argonne Offensive.
