The James B. Eads Award is presented annually to the most outstanding Camp in the Department of Missouri. James Eads moved to St. Louis, Missouri as a young teenager and took odd jobs to sustain himself. Though Eads' formal schooling ended before he was 14, he learned mathematics and the sciences on his own. **Eads' energy and inventiveness resulted in his becoming a prominent riverine engineer by the time of the Civil War and turned out to be an invaluable asset in helping the Union regain control of the Mississippi River.**
