—A new patriotic organization has been formed in Ste. Genevieve. It is the Augustine Siebert Camp No. 11. Sons of Veterans. The officers are Lawrence Herzog, Commander; Joseph Herzog, Sr. Vice Com.; Chas. Brannaman, Jr. Vice Com.; John W. Schwent, Sec; John W. Roth, Treasurer; Frank Herzog, Chap

lain; the non-commissioned officers will be appointed at the installation. Every young man who has had relatives at one time soldiers should apply for membership, and there are enough such to give us one of the biggest Camps in the State. The S. of V's are the direct successors to the G. A. R., and besides the perpetuation of the memory and spirit of the Grand Army, there are social and other features that will make it a pleasure and a benefit to belong to the Sons of Veterans.
