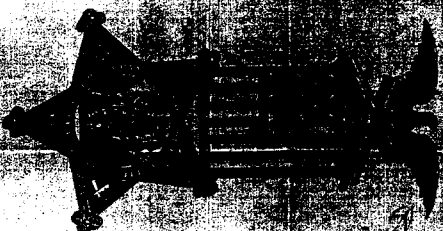

And I further do and empower them to perform all acts necessary to conduct said organization in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Grand Army of the Republic.

Dated at the Head Quarters of the Department of Missouri of the Grand Army of the Republic at St. Louis on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and twenty-five and of our Independence the one hundred and twenty.
