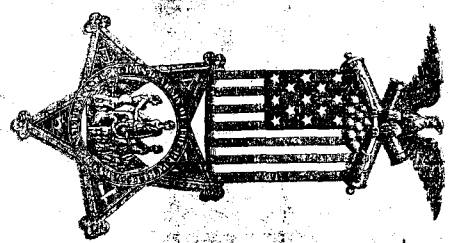

Dated at the Head Quarters of the Illinois Department of the Grand Army of the Republic at St. Louis, on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Eighty Five and of our Independence the 1<sup>st</sup> hundred and seventy.
