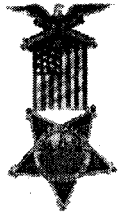

Frederick Heck[er] Post, No. 29, G.A.R., was organized October 15, 1886, with seventeen members. The first officers were: J.W. Gardner, Com.; J.C. Lesaulnier, Adj.; Emil Zetzman, S.V.C.; Adolph Stricker, J.V.C.; MenryMelhouse, Chap.; Henry Reis, O.D.; William Hains, O.G.; Nicholas Rau, Q.M.; William Thompson, I.G.; Elisha Pyeatt, O.G.; J.B. Calkins, Surg. The membership, November 1, 1887, was forty.

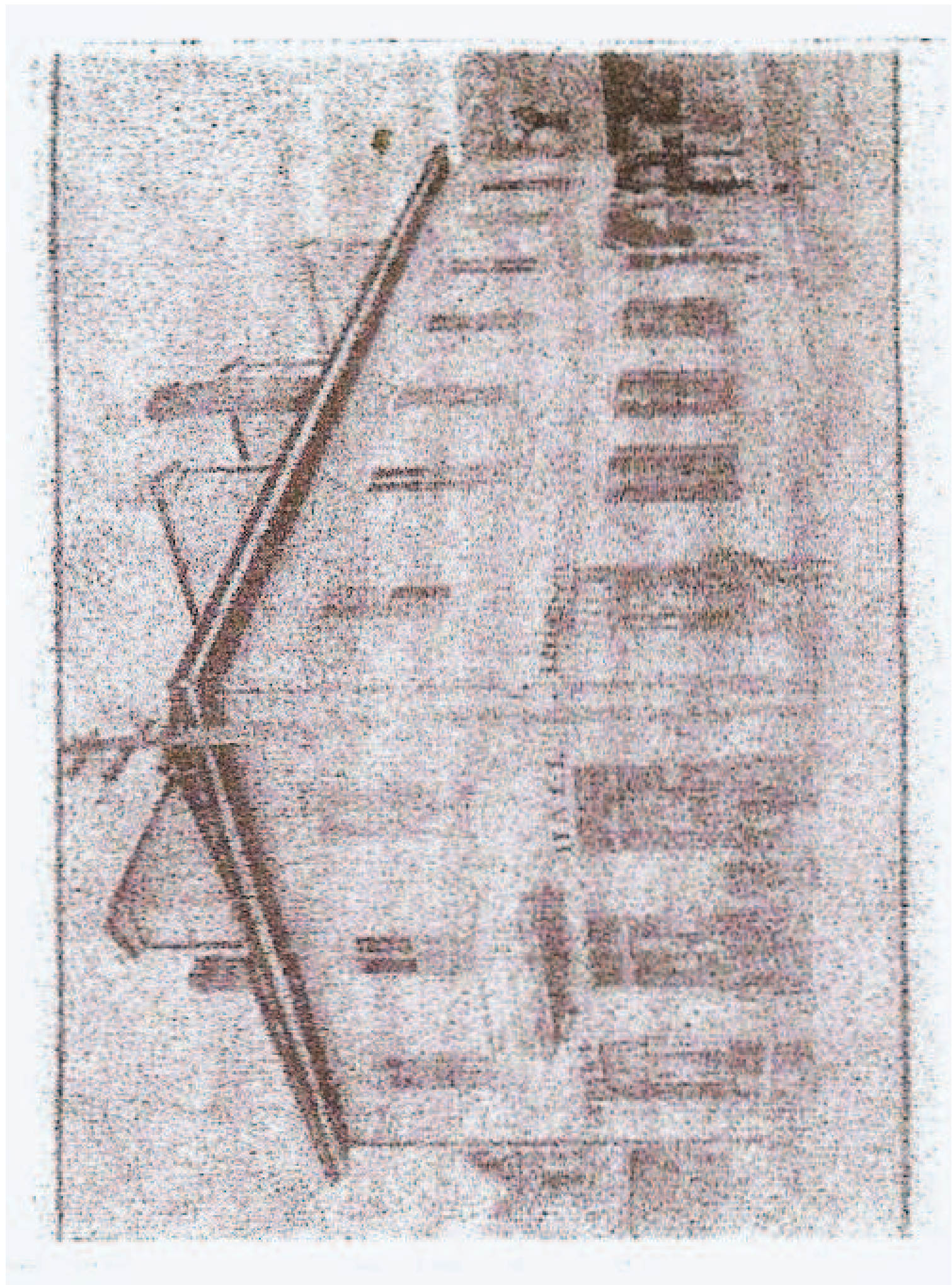

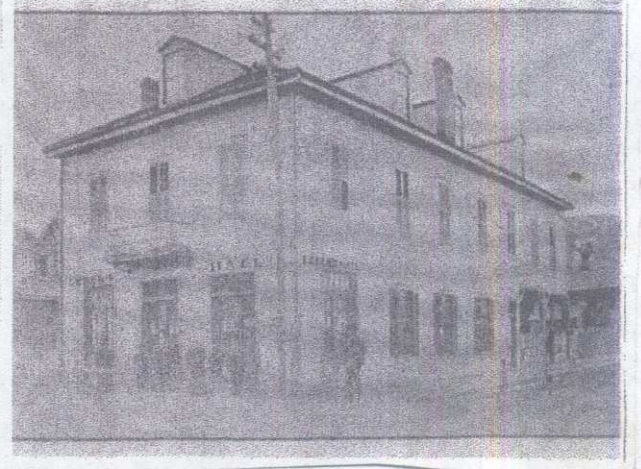
