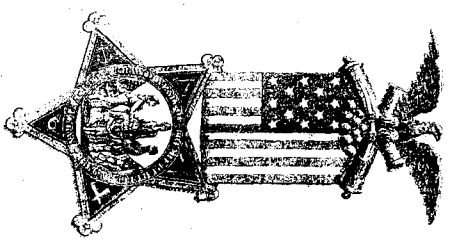

Dated at the Grand Quarters of the Department of Missouri of the Grand Army of the Republic at St. Louis, Mo. on the 10th day of November 1880 in the presence of Gen. Lewis and Capt. Goodrich and of our Independence the one hundred and
