From Goodspeed's History of Southeast Missouri: "Gen. James H. Hart Post No. 333, G.A.R., was organized on August 16, 1887, with the following officers: Ben. A. Hamilton, P.C.; O.L. Davis, S.V.C.; John Head, J.V.C.; Jacob Collier, Chaplain; B.F. Harrison, Surgeon; T.C. Hayley, Q. M.; J.F. Lindsay, Adj., and John Short, O. of G. There are now about forty members.

Additional Information is in a local history book, which gives the location of their meeting hall. The book is "Wayne County MO" by Rose Fulton Cramer.

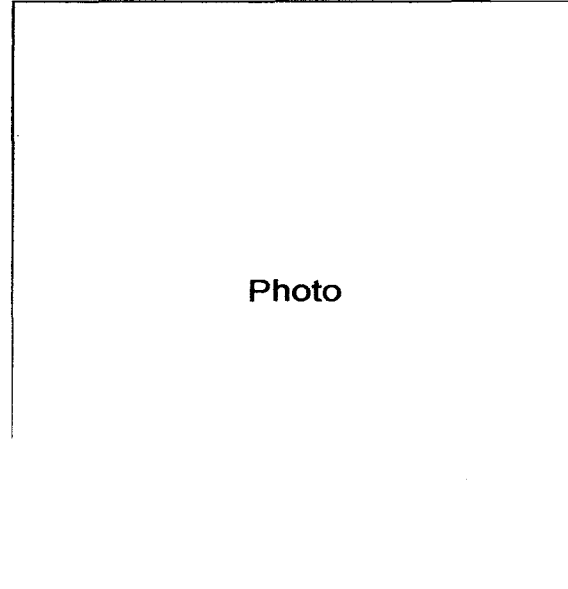

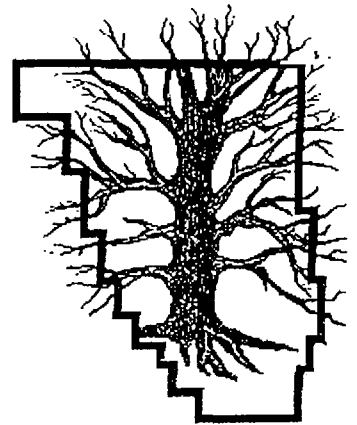

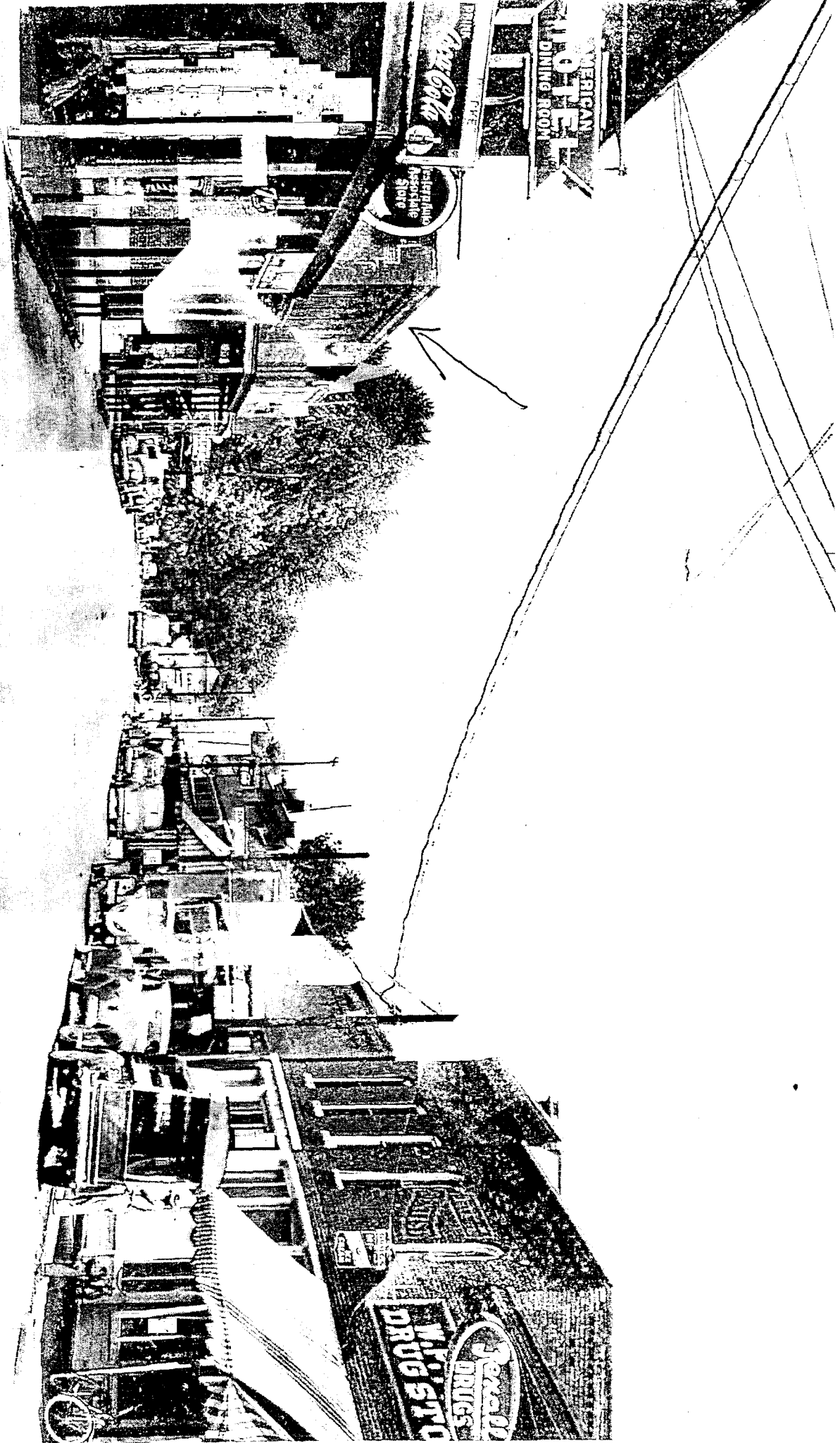
