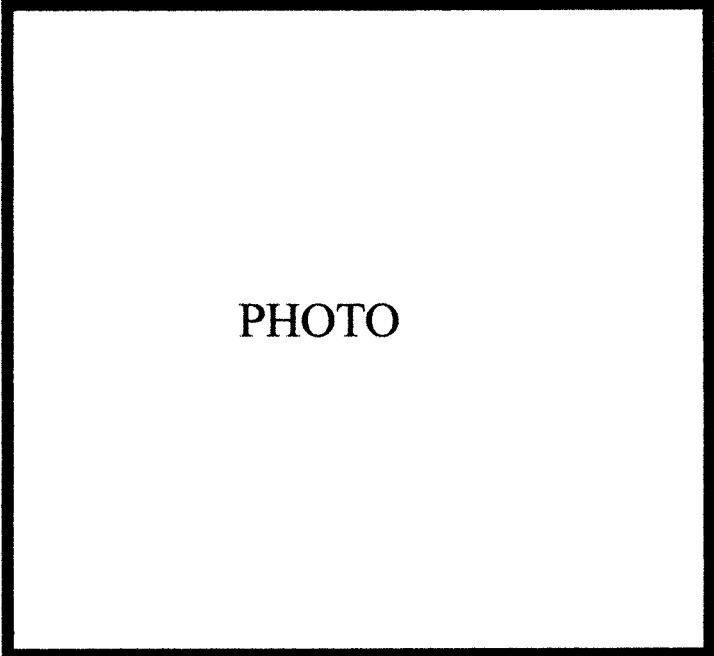

Brief History

The Gatzweiler G.A.R. Post # 554 in St. Charles, MO met in two different places according to the St. Charles city directories that have been found. The post met at the Odd Fellows Hall on 117 South Main St. in St. Charles and also at 226 North Main St. at the Central Hall. According to the Missouri Death Records of the G.A.R. their first recorded death was in 1897 with their last recorded death was in two members in 1934.
