Picnics, Parades and the G. A. R. Were Popular

Very religious, and very patriotic, the old soldiers of Taney county never missed an opportunity for a public picnic or a parade. This photograph, from the Douglas Mahnkey collection, was taken in the early 1900s. It

portrays a group from Taney County who gathered in Bradleyville to participate in a parade and picnic sponsored by the Grand Army of the Republic. Note the rope-tightened bass and snare drums, the flag bearer,

etc. Every man standing erect, the "old soldiers" personified pride and patriotism. Holding the sword, first man in the bottom row, was Joe Mosely. Directly behind him was Len Walker.
