Was started May 1888. They received their charter on 8 Dec 1888. Sergeant Arthur C. Bantz served in Co. K, 47th MO Infantry and died on 19 Apr 1865 shortly after returning from Tennessee. His brother Judge William A. Bantz was the initiating officer. He was a member of the G.A.R. Captain/Commander around 1889 was W.J. Rattler and 1st Sgt was J.W. Schmahle. In 1889 the camp was under suspension according to the 1889 Roster
