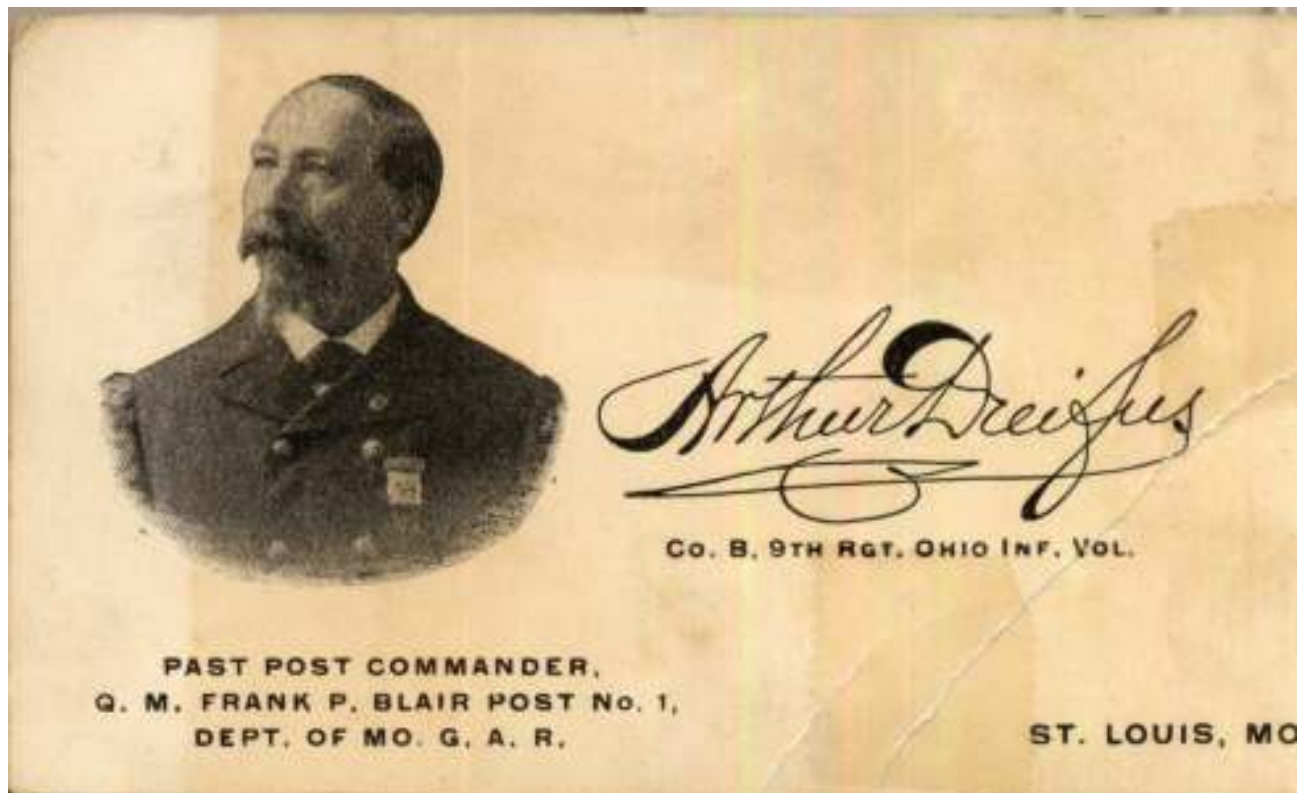


Arthur Dreifus 1913

Arthur Dreifus was a past commander and charter member of Frank P. Blair Post 1, St. Louis. He was born on June 6, 1838 in Endigen, Switzerland, to Marcus Dreifus and his wife. The war saw him serving, according to one researcher, as a member of Col. Bob McCook's Co. B, 9th OH Inf. During his life he was a notary and a pension agent. His wife's name was Alma, who had 3 daughters with him. He passed away on Feb 18, 1915 and was cremated.
