Death of "Ben" Prack.

Was Assistant Ticket Agent of the Frisco for Many Years.

Bernard Prack, who for the past eight years was assistant ticket agent of the St. Louis and San Francisco in this city died yesterday at Okawville, Ill., from inflammatory rheumatism. "Ben" Prack, as he was called by his friends, was compelled to abandon his office work at Broadway and Chestnut street about five weeks ago. On the advice of his physician he went to Okawville one month ago, and for a while gave evidences of improving. A severe relapse, however, set in a few days ago, and his wife was telegraphed for. She was with him when the end came.

Mr. Prack lived with his wife and baby, a boy 18 months old, at No. 2727 St. Vincent avenue. The body will be brought to St. Louis for burial.
