Vern is a member of the John H. McNeil Camp # 62 in northern Missouri. He attended Northeast Missouri State University in Kirksville, and received a Bachelor of Science in Education degree. He taught school in Wyaconda, MO for 4 years and Green City, MO for 26 years, retiring in 2005. Vern and his wife, Nancy, live on a small farm in Sullivan County.

He joined the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War on August 10, 1996 at the 115th National Encampment in Columbus, Ohio. He became a member of the Grant Camp #68 in St. Louis and was initiated into the order during the assembly of the National Convention. In 2000 he was elected Department Commander. During his tenure, he helped plan the first National Convention to be held in Missouri.

His Civil War ancestors were John Potter, 1st MO Cavalry; Grandville Vanderpool and Moses Vanderpool, both in 35th MO Infantry; Garrett Humphreys 7th MO Cavalry; and Samuel M. Smith 21st MO Infantry.
