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Articles of Agreement of Incorporation

We the following named persons to wit:
W. A. Robinson Post commander, J. F.
Stanhope Adjutant, J. H. Scott Quartermaster
officer and the members of Marionville
Post No 141 Grand Army of the Republic,
assembled at an adjourned meeting,
held in Post rooms in the town of
Marionville county of Lawrence and State
of Missouri) on the 27th day of Feb, 1886,
did by unanimous vote adopt the
following Rules and Objects, for the further
promotion of our Organization.

Article 1st

This Association shall be known as
Marionville Post No 141 Grand Army of
the Republic. Department of Mo.

Article 2^d

The Objects to be accomplished by
Organization are as follows.

1st

To preserve and strengthen those
kind and fraternal feelings which
bind together the Soldiers Sailors and
Mariners, who united to suppress the
late Rebellion, and to preserve the
memory and history of the dead.

2^d

To assist such former comrades
in arms, as need help and protection,
and to extend needful aid to the Widows
and Orphans of those who have fallen.

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7 To maintain true allegiance to the United States of America, based upon a paramount respect for, and fidelity, to the National constitution and laws, to discontinuance whatever tends to weaken loyalty, incites, to insurrection, treason or rebellion, or in any manner impairs the efficiency and permanency of our free institutions, and to encourage the spread of universal liberty, equal rights and justice all men.

4th For the relief and aid of the Widows and Orphans of our fallen comrades, or for assisting such as may be sick or disabled, from the proceeds of Relief funds or assessments upon the members of organization

Article 3rd Sec. 1st for the purpose of owning and controlling Property Grounds and Buildings necessary for the accommodations of said Post, to be located and Situated in the Town of Marionville County of Lawrence and State of Missouri.

4th Monday it being the 22^d day
of February 1886, there were present
Hon. M. C. Mc Gregor, Judge of the
15th Judicial Circuit of Missouri, Mr.
B. Skinner, prosecuting attorney of
Lawrence county, John L. Whaley
Sheriff and H. H. Cecil, Clerk, at
which time and place and on
Monday March 1, 1886, the 7th Judi-

ing, among other proceedings, were
had in words and figures follow-
ing to-wit:

and J. H. Scott, D. M., and others,
officers of the above named asso-
ciation, for incorporation, and it
appearing from the articles of
Agreement and petition heretofore
filed in this cause, that the object and
purpose of said incorporation is
lawful and of public useful-
ness and that the articles of
Agreement aforesaid and the
purposes aforesaid come under
the purview of Article 10 Chapter
21 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri
and are not inconsistent with the
constitution and laws of the United
States or of the State of Missouri,
the prayer of the said petitioners
is granted and said petitioners
and those associated with them
are consolidated and united
into a corporation and declared
a body corporate under the name
and style of "The Marionville Post
No. 141 of the department of
Missouri G. A. R." as aforesaid
said Article 10 Chapter 21 of

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the Revised Statutes of Missouri,
and as such entitled to all the
rights and privileges and immunities
conferred by law.
