This (next page) is a rare example of an original Sons of Veterans member's metal from Colonel H. J. Kline, Camp 183, that was base in Fairport, DeKalb Co. The camp was created in 1890 and named after the 1890 SV Missouri Commander. This metal looks to be made of German silver and measures 2 and 1/2" tall and 1 and 3/4" wide. It is nicely engrave with the original owner's name, "Wm. Wolf" along with the camps' name and number. The back is marked with the maker's name "Trebus & Steiner, St. Louis". This is an excellent example but the pin is missing from the back.
