

#### Historical Records Officer Report

The webmaster is still working on getting the rest of the information on line. He was on vacation and apparently my package of info was misplaced so it was recently re-sent in. All of this info should be on the web once he updates it.

GAR Commander Bios: Arkansas 13 bios. Missouri 67 bios, most now with photographs. Need as least some info on one or two Missouri Commanders and on almost all the Arkansas Commanders. Spent a few hours at St. Louis City Library photographing commanders and copying bios out of the department encampment records they hold.

- Last Solider Project: Arkansas 4 candidates from 75 counties. This needs a lot of work. Missouri 115 counties with 115+ candidates. Most Missouri candidates should be good, but camps still need to verify with me before placing "last soldier markers"
- SV/SUV Commanders: Arkansas 2 known/ 1 bio. A lot of research is needed. Missouri 77 names known, missing 12 years, 50 bios.
- GAR Posts: 248 Posts have PDFs in computer out of 137 Arkansas Posts and 594 Missouri Posts. Five posts have been updated this past year.
- Medal of Honor Records Static -- Arkansas has 2 and Missouri has 35 listed.
- GAR Documents: Besides some of the documents that we have in the post records on-line. We are adding soon the Missouri GAR encampment proceedings from 1893-1927. Also the articles of incorporation papers and a memorial address from the 1870 GAR Missouri Commander.
- SV/SUV Camps: Arkansas 40 known camps with 34 having pdfs. Missouri 252 known camps with 168 having pdfs.

A woman is in contact with me after Brother Glen Alsop forwarded her information to me. Apparently she has records for the Missouri Auxiliary in the 1920s and apparently this also might include records from the Rassieur Camp in St. Louis. She has promised to provide us at least copies of documents.





It is my observation that consistent individual camp participation at the Department level needs to be encouraged from all camps in the Department of Missouri.

It is also my observation that the awards currently given by this Department do not address this need for such encouragement among all aforesaid camps.

Therefore, I propose the creation of the following award, to be presented annually to as many camps as meet the criteria for the previous administrative year.

#### MAJOR WILLIAM WARNER CAMP OF DISTINCTION AWARD

Major William Warner rose to the rank of Major in the Wisconsin Infantry, and was an original member of the Missouri Commandery of the Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States, Insignia #3819. He was elected a member of the Post No. 8 at Kansas City, Missouri, Missouri Department, Grand Army of the Republic, Member #372,960, was the first Department Commander of Missouri, and was elected Senior Vice Commander-in-Chief in 1887 and the 17th Commander-in-Chief of the Grand Army of the Republic in 1888. He died October 4, 1916 at Kansas City, Missouri, at the age of 77.

# THE CRITERIA FOR THE MAJOR WILLIAM WARNER CAMP OF DISTINCTION AWARD WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) The award will be called the Major William Warner Camp of Distinction Award, and camps receiving this award can identify themselves as a [Year of Award] Camp of Distinction.
- 2) The Major William Warner Camp of Distinction Award will be awarded to one or more Camps in the Department of Missouri, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, who in the previous administrative year: submitted all camp reports, including four Quarterly Reports, Form 22, and Form 27; was represented at all Department Business meetings and the annual Department Encampment; and submitted an article about the camp's activities to the Missouri Unionist for each issue in that administrative year.
- 3) Additional criteria may be added provided those criteria are published by the Department Encampment previous to the Department Encampment at which the Award is presented.

#### Historical Records Officer Report

The webmaster is still working on getting the rest of the information on line. He was on vacation and apparently my package of info was misplaced so it was recently re-sent in. All of this info should be on the web once he updates it.

GAR Commander Bios: Arkansas 13 bios. Missouri 67 bios, most now with photographs. Need as least some info on one or two Missouri Commanders and on almost all the Arkansas Commanders. Spent a few hours at St. Louis City Library photographing commanders and copying bios out of the department encampment records they hold.

- Last Solider Project: Arkansas 4 candidates from 75 counties. This needs a lot of work. Missouri 115 counties with 115+ candidates. Most Missouri candidates should be good, but camps still need to verify with me before placing "last soldier markers"
- SV/SUV Commanders: Arkansas 2 known/ 1 bio. A lot of research is needed. Missouri 77 names known, missing 12 years, 50 bios.
- GAR Posts: 248 Posts have PDFs in computer out of 137 Arkansas Posts and 594 Missouri Posts. Five posts have been updated this past year.
- Medal of Honor Records Static -- Arkansas has 2 and Missouri has 35 listed.
- GAR Documents: Besides some of the documents that we have in the post records on-line. We are adding soon the Missouri GAR encampment proceedings from 1893-1927. Also the articles of incorporation papers and a memorial address from the 1870 GAR Missouri Commander.
- SV/SUV Camps: Arkansas 40 known camps with 34 having pdfs. Missouri 252 known camps with 168 having pdfs.

A woman is in contact with me after Brother Glen Alsop forwarded her information to me. Apparently she has records for the Missouri Auxiliary in the 1920s and apparently this also might include records from the Rassieur Camp in St. Louis. She has promised to provide us at least copies of documents.
