

Post meetings, May 1887 through at least October 3, 1894, were held in the Farmington Knights of Pythias Hall. October 3, 1894 the post decided that future meetings were to be held at the Odd Fellows Hall, which was being built (completed in 1896) at the corner of Columbia and Washington Streets (the southeast corner). The post began holding meetings here after its completion (it is now the site of the Ozarks Federal Savings building).

Additional Information

The post originally was organized and met in Bonne Terre, Missouri.


