

Petts, it will be noticed was a charter member of the US Grant Post and the Farnsworth Post, indeed his connection with the loyal fraternity has been extensive and varied. Originally, he was a charter member of Post 19, at Watseka, Illinois, at a time when the GAR was organized outside of Illinois, where all Posts were numbered merely, but not named.								
	Afterwards, before coming to Missouri, he organized the Union League, at Chicago, at present he is probably the oldest member of the GAR now living in Benton county, by which this is to be understood not that he is the oldest man in years but in membership in that fraternity.
