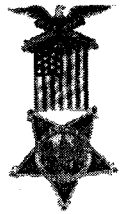

Fred Steele Post, No. 244, G. A. R., of Cole Camp, was chartered September 1, 1885, with John F. Feldman, John Z. Erhard, August Benz, S. T. Hayes, Richard M. Neff, H. M. McCall, W. R. D. Mabry, John B. Howry, John Harms, Hinrich Harms, M. Schumacher, George Friemuth and Claus Mahnken, as original members. The first officers were: John F. Feldman, P. C.; Claus Mahnken, Sr. V. C.; Richard M. Neff, Jr. V. C.; H. M. McCall, O. D.; Hinrich Harms, O. G.; M. Schumacher, Treas.; W. R. D. Mabry, Adjt.; August Benz, S. M.. Present officers: P. F. Abbott, P. C.; John F. Feldman, Sr. V. C.; John Z. Erhard, Jr. V. C.; H. M. McCall, O. D.; Henry Bishop, O. G.; Henry Mahnken, Q. M.; R. M. Neff, Chaplain; E. J. Phypher, P. S.; H. Edwoods, Adjt.
