

Osceola. St. Clair Co.

And I authorize and empower them to perform all acts necessary to conduct said organization in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Grand Army of the Republic.

Dated at the Head Quarters of the Department of Missouri of the Grand Army of the Republic at St. Louis on the ninth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty eight and of our Independence the One hundred and thirty seventh.
