Ninety-two, and of our Independence the One hundred and

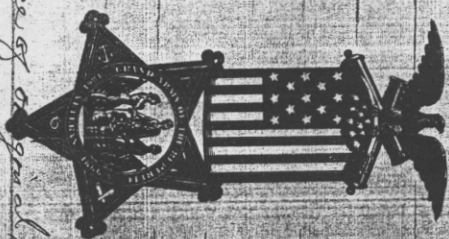
