He is on the list from 1928 of past division commanders, but the list doesn't give dates of command. It seems that it was probably around 1922. The only sources of information so far are his death certificate and info from findagrave.com listed below.

In the 1939 book, he was asking for his honors as a Past Missouri Department Commander restored. It states that he was apparently dropped from the rolls in 1925 but has since been reinstated in the Charles H. Morgan Camp #37 [Joplin, MO - chartered in 1919]. It states he has been very active. It states the department of Missouri has passed a resolution calling for his reinstatement. It also states that the committee reviewing it at the national level are looking upon it favorably. The snippet in Google Books does not say if he was eventually reinstated to Dept Commander honors or not.
