




Series 1998-1999

1. 1st Quarter Camp per capita tax is due on or before April 1st. Please send this information into the Department Sec/Tres Bob Petrovic.
2. Note that the new per capita tax for the Department is effective starting this quarter. Dues owed the Department are now \$1.50 per quarter. Camps will need to send a total of \$4.00 per member to cover the National and Department per capita tax for the quarter. This will allow the Department to function without the help of the raffles. Raffle money can now be set aside for the 2001 National Encampment in Springfield, Missouri.
3. John Rutherford has asked that any member that has any of the ribbons and metals from the past National Encampments to bring them to the Department meeting for him to review.
4. Please note that the Department Commander Steven Leicht has a new e-mail address SentryRem@aol.com. Please make the necessary changes in your records.
5. If any Camp has any new members who joined their Camp, please send the name and address of the member to the Department Commander. I would like to send the new recruits a letter welcoming them into the Organization. You will still need to send the application into the Department Sec/Tres with your per capita tax.
6. The Department is going to be handing out additional information to be placed into the Camp information packets. It is recommended that the Camps purchase a larger binder to hold this information and any addition information in the future. I recommend at least a 2" binder.
7. Camp Information Packets are to be transferred to newly elected Commanders upon installation. Updating information within the packets will be the responsibility of the Camps.
8. A list of the Camp property is to be turned into the Department with the Officer installation forms.
9. The date of the next National Encampment is August 19th - 22nd in Indianapolis, Indiana. Information pertaining to the National Encampment will be handed out at the Department meeting.
10. The next Department meeting will be held in Columbia, Missouri on February 27, 1999. It will be located at Lefebvre Hall at the College. Meeting will start at 1pm. A map will be sent to the Camp Commanders of the location of the meeting location.
