These badges worn by Jonathan Hollingwith during his service to the G.AR.


































## MO COMMANDER AJP BARNES



This photograph shows Mr. A. J. P. Barnes quietly observing his 93d birthday anniversary, March 29, 1936 at his home 1606 Kentucky Avenue, Joplin, Mo. He was born March 29, 1843 in a two room log cabin on a farm in Carroll County, Indiana. He enlisted as a private in Company H, Second Iowa Infantry at Washington, Iowa May 1, 1861. He was mustered into United States Service May 23, 1861 at Keokuk, Iowa. Later he was commissioned a First Lieutenant in another regiment and was honorably mustered out of service January 31, 1866 at Huntsville, Alabama. He served as a State Commander, Department Missouri, G. A. R. Series 1921-22. He was a member of Fifty-first Missouri General Assembly and two Special Sessions as Representative from the Third District, Jasper County. With the exception of neuratic and common old age infirmities, Mr. Barnes is enjoying good health. His mental faculties are well preserved and active for one of such advanced years.
