Sigel Camp #614, Department of Missouri, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, passed the second quarter of 2013 by attending and participating in several events hosted by other camps and community organizations honoring Union Veterans of the Civil War. Camp Commander C. Scott Brown attended the first of these events on May 27, 2013, representing his camp and the Order with his participation in the Memorial Day ceremony sponsored by the South Central Regional Veterans Group at Veterans Memorial Park in Rolla.

Sigel Camp #614 Senior Vice Commander Randal A. Burd, Jr., who is also Secretary for the Department of Missouri, and his father Randal A. Burd, Sr., represented the Rolla camp at the Department of Missouri Encampment at Holiday Inn South in Mehlville, Missouri, on June 1, 2013. The Department of Missouri (which includes Arkansas) was delighted to have as guests SUVCW National Commander-in-Chief Perley Mellor from New Hampshire and Auxiliary to the SUVCW National President Jane Graham from Ohio and her staff. 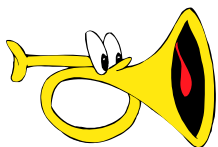

HOMESTYLE HARDTACK

5 LBS. UNBLEACHED ALL PURPOSE FLOUR
2 TBS. BAKING POWDER
1 TBS. SALT (optional)
5-6 CUPS COOL WATER...
ENOUGH TO MAKE A **STIFF, DRY DOUGH**.

If dough becomes too stiff to work, add more water. If too moist, add flour. It may be easier to start with a moist dough, then add flour to each part as you work the dough with your hands before rolling. If dough sticks or strings to cutter, it is too moist!!! Roll the dough ¼ to ½ inch thick, use the cutter for measuring thickness. Bake on ungreased cookie sheet until bone dry.

THE HOW TO

Start mixing dough with fork, then use hands to form a workable dough ball. Roll about ½ of the dough at a time. When dough is right consistency, it will take some **“power rolling”** to get dough to the right thickness. Use flour sprinkles liberally on rolling surface to prevent sticking. Bake at 300 degrees for 70-90 minutes, or until biscuit can no longer be pushed in (soft), using finger to test. The hardtack will get harder as it cools, but a “cakelike” inside will not harden and will have to be put back in the oven to finish “drying” (baking). If you prefer a softer inside for easier eating, reduce baking time. The overall look will be the same. This hardtack is edible, but storage time has yet to be determined. **DO NOT STORE IN PLASTIC;**
DO NOT FREEZE!! A dry tin container is the best.
