Passing of Brother Mark S Schreiber

It is with this sorrow that the Department of Missouri, Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, reports the passing of Brother Mark S Schreiber on 17 November 2025.

Brother Schreiber was a member of Lillie Camp #6

Brother Schreiber was born in Springfield, Missouri in 1954. Graduated 1964 from Jefferson City Senior High School, he then attended Central Missouri State College and finished his B.S. degree in Management from Sterling College. Completed an M.S. degree in Criminal Justice at Columbia College, where he also taught for several years.

He spent his 44-year career in the field of criminal justice at the Missouri State Penitentiary and was awarded the Missouri Department of Corrections Director's Coin of Excellence and received resolutions from the Missouri Senate and House of Representative in recognition of his service in criminal justice. He is survived by his wife Deborah (Debbie) F. Tritsch and family.

Visitation will be on November 24, 2025, at 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. at Houser-Millard Funeral Home, Jefferson City, where funeral services will follow at 12 p.m.
