#### WILSON'S CREEK NATIONAL BAT-TLEFIELD FOUNDATION PURCHAS-ES RARE MANUSCRIPT OF MARY WHITNEY PHELPS

In 2021, the Wilson's Creek National Battlefield Foundation purchased an incomplete manuscript written by Mary Whitney Phelps from Swann Auction Galleries in New York City.

The undated manuscript details her experiences in the early months of the war, during the Wilson's Creek campaign.

The manuscript has been digitized and will be upload for free access on the Springfield-Greene County Library's "Community and Conflict" site (https://ozarkscivilwar.org). The library predicts that the public will have access to this rare memoir and other Phelps documents by the end of January.
